

OFFICIAL RULES FOR THE NZIC IYPT VIDEO CONTEST

Promotion Description: The New Zealand Institute of Chemistry (NZIC) and the Royal Society of Chemistry NZ branch (RSC) are running a student video competition in honour of the International Year of the Periodic table 2019.

Submitted videos must describe — in an innovative, engaging and entertaining manner — one element from the 118 elements of the periodic table.

Winners in each category will be chosen by a panel based on:

- Keeping to time (less than 2 minutes)
- The clarity of the story line in the video
- The clarity of the explanation of the element
- The accuracy of the description of the element
- Innovation and creativity of the approach to visual and audio presentation

Winners will be notified by email and announced online by the NZIC. The videos of the winners will be screened at the 2019 NZIC conference in Christchurch in November 2019, and posted on the NZIC YouTube channel.

Prizes for the winners of each category will consist of:

- 1st Prize \$300 and a copy of the book Scientific Sleuthing
- 2nd Prize \$200 and a copy of the book Scientific Sleuthing
- 3rd Prize \$100 and a copy of the book Scientific Sleuthing

By participating in the Contest, each entrant unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of the NZIC which shall be final and binding in all respects.

Eligibility: The contest has two judging categories: Junior/Intermediate School (Years 1-8) and Senior School (Years 9-13). Individual and group/team/class entries are both welcome, however entries are limited to New Zealand residents only.

How to Enter: Participants must produce a video that is (a) original, (b) 60-120 seconds in duration, (c) describing one of the chemical elements. The video must be submitted to the NZIC – please contact nzic.office@gmail.com for instructions on where to upload the video.

By submitting an entry, you confirm that you have the right, including any required permission of individuals depicted in the video, to publicly display the video. You also confirm that you have the right to incorporate into your video and publicly perform any music accompaniment in the video.

All entries must be received before 1 October 2019 to be eligible. The NZIC is not responsible for late, lost, or misdirected entries that are not received in a timely manner, or are lost due to computer or electronic malfunction or other error, or due to inaccessibility of the Internet or portions thereof.

Additional Rules Relating to the Submission of Videos: By submitting any Video to the Contest, Participants hereby grant to the NZIC and its affiliates, subsidiaries, licensees and assigns, an irrevocable, perpetual and royalty-free right to use, reproduce, edit, display, transmit, prepare derivative works of, modify, publish and otherwise make use of the submitted Video in any and all media, whether now known or hereinafter created, throughout the world and for any purpose. In addition to other things, the rights granted to the NZIC include but are not limited to the right to censor, compress, edit, feature, caption, affix logos to, and to otherwise alter or make use of the submitted video.

In addition, by submitting any video to the Site, Participants hereby represent and warrant that the submitted video or information does not and shall not infringe on any copyright or other right of any third party, and Participant has the right to grant any and all rights and licenses granted to the NZIC herein, including but not limited to all necessary rights under copyright, free and clear of any claims or encumbrances. The NZIC may, but shall have no obligation to, post, display or otherwise make publicly available any video submitted by you, and may, in its sole and unfettered discretion, remove, edit, modify or delete any portion of the video or information that you submit to the Site.

Privacy: Information provided to enter the Contest will not be sold to third parties but may be shared as may be necessary for the purposes of conducting and judging the Contest or making use of the submitted video as permitted by these Official Rules. The NZIC, its affiliates, and companies supplying prizes (or parts thereof) in connection with this Contest may from time to time contact entrants via email concerning the Contest, and each entrant consents to receiving such communications via email.

Automated Entries Prohibited: No mechanically reproduced, incomplete, forged, software generated or automated multiple entries will be accepted.

Release: Acceptance of a prize constitutes the prize winner's permission for the NZIC to use prize winner's name and likeness for advertising and/or promotional purposes worldwide and in all forms of media in perpetuity without further compensation or authorization.
